The other day I was contacted by a lady who's father lives in Paris, France and used to work for Citroën as did his father before him. Turns out he is in possession of 2 antique broaches that André Citroën commissioned in 1928 and were handed out to invitees at a luncheon by André at in 1930.



As her father is now getting quite old, she reached out to Citroenvie in the hope that they would go to suitably appreciative Citroenthusiasts.

If you're been checking out the Citroënvie site this month, I hope you took the time to scroll through the extensive article we featured on <u>David Allen</u>. It's a great read with dozens of documents showing how David brokered Citroëns in the USA and Canada in the 1980s and early 1990s.


